



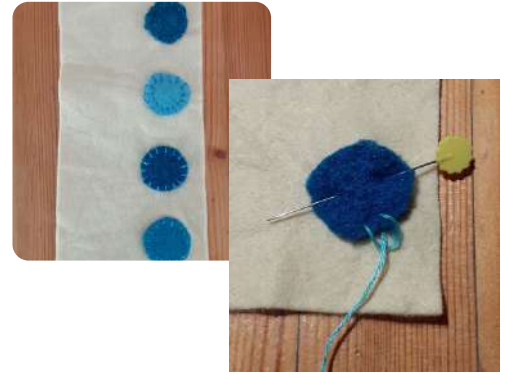
Remake Crafts: Bookmark



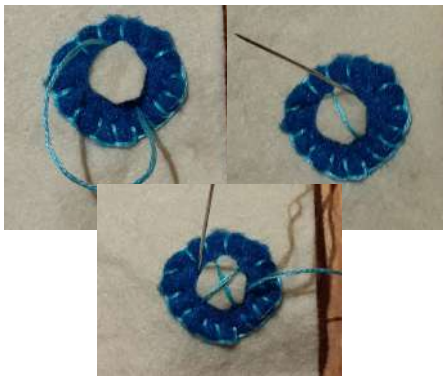
1: Make an applique bookmark with tassel. Techniques: blanket stitch or simple method, & tassel making (see **stitch guide**)



2: Materials: 1 of 18 x9 cm fabric, 4 x 2.5 cm fabric circle, 4 x 1 cm fabric circle, needle, pins embroidery thread, wool



3: Pin the four 2.5 cm circles onto one half of the fabric. Sew the circles on using blanket stitch or simple method (see **stitch guide**).



4: Pin the smaller circles onto of the larger circles & sew on using 3 straight stitches crossing over the whole circle.



5: Tassel: using a credit card or cardboard rectangle wind 20 rounds of thread finishing at the same end as you started. This is the bottom.



6: Cut a 20cm length of thread, slip in under the top of the card & tie a knot. Slip this off the card & cut through the bottom loops



7: Cut a 10cm length and tie it round the bundle, 2 or 3 cm down from the top. Cut the loops at the end of the tassel & trim any uneven ends.



8: Fold the bookmark fabric in half with the right side facing outwards. Place the tassel ends inside and pin the fabric together.



9: Sew all round the edge of the bookmark using blanket stitch or simple method (see **stitch guide**).
